Opening Prayer Intentions

For the intentions of the Holy Father, Pope N.____, we pray to the Lord

Response: *Recite one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory Be.*

For our Bishop, N.____, for our priests, seminarians, deacons, brothers, sisters, religious and all those living a consecrated life, and for all those discerning a call to religious life, we pray to the Lord. Response: *Recite one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory Be.*

For our personal intentions, and the intentions of all those gathered here.... (offer aloud or in the silence of your hearts). We pray to the Lord. Response: *Recite one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory Be.*

Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross. Then, pray the Apostles' Creed.
2. On this first bead pray the Our Father.
3. On these 3 beads pray 3 Hail Marys.
4. Here, between the beads, pray the Glory be.
5. Announce: "The 5 Joyful (or Sorrowful, or Glorious, or Luminous) Mysteries. The first (Joyful) Mystery, The Annunciation." Read the scripture verse and the prayer. Then pray the Our Father
6. Pray 10 Hail Marys.
7. Between the beads pray the Glory be and the Decade Prayer.
8. Announce the second mystery, and repeat steps 5, 6 and 7. Then do the same with the remaining 3 decades.
9. After having finished all 5 decades, conclude by praying the Hail Holy Queen and the final prayer.

The Joyful Mysteries - Monday & Saturday

1. The Annunciation - Luke 1:26-38

God, your Word comes to us as a gentle invitation to know you better and to follow your will. Help us to be open to your call in our lives, and, like Mary, to respond to that call generously. Guide those whom you have called to priesthood and consecrated life to dedicate themselves to you as your servants. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

2. The Visitation - Luke 1:39-45

God, your life stirs our hearts to love and to service. Help us to seek you ever more in service to our brothers and sisters, and lead those who hear your call to priesthood and consecrated life to give you glory through lives of faithful service. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

3. The Nativity of the Lord - Luke 2:1-7

God, your Son became flesh for the salvation of the world. Hear us as we ask you to raise up in your Church new servants of your incarnate Word, to make Jesus present through the sacraments and through loving service to others. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

4. The Presentation of the Lord - Luke 2:22-35

God, as your Son was presented in the Temple as your gift to Mary and Joseph, help us to offer to you our lives in response to your call. May those who hear a call to priesthood and consecrated life generously offer their gifts of themselves and find the courage to be signs of contradiction in our world. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

5. The Finding of Jesus in the Temple - Luke 2:41-52

God, help us to seek you where you may be found. May we who hear your call to be your light to the world find the courage to offer to you lives of service and joy in response to the generous gifts of life and love you have given to us. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Luminous Mysteries - Thursday

1. The Baptism of the Lord - Mark 1:9-11

Lord God, in our Baptism you have given each of us a unique vocation. Help us to live lives of holiness and dedication to you. May we always seek to do your will and be found worthy to hear that you are well pleased with us. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

2. The Wedding at Cana - John 2:1-11

Lord God, at Cana Jesus blessed marriage as a reflection of His love for the Church. May those who are called to this vocation of love be found chaste and faithful in their vows, and may those who are called to be your brides and bridegrooms in vocations of service remain single-hearted in their dedication to you and your Church. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom - Mark 1:14-15

Lord God, your Word reaches to the ends of the earth. Send more ministers of that Word into the world to share the richness of your life with a world that so desperately needs it. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

4. The Transfiguration of the Lord - Mark 9:2-8

Lord God, in Jesus we see the fullness of your revelation to the world. Help us to remain fixed on His light, and help those whom you call to the priesthood and consecrated life to reflect that light to the world. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

5. The Institution of the Eucharist - Mark 14:22-25

Lord God, in the Eucharist we receive the fullness of your life and love; we taste heaven and are promised eternal life. Send more faithful servants of this mystery into your Church and raise up new priests to renew this Sacrament of love. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Sorrowful Mysteries - Tuesday & Friday

1. The Agony in the Garden - Mark 14:32-36

Lord, often we feel burdened beyond our ability to endure. Help us to see in your holy will the freedom of the children of God. Give to those who hear a call to priesthood and consecrated life the strength and courage to respond to your will generously and with love. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

2. The Scourging at the Pillar - Luke 23:13-16

Lord, this world does not always understand the choice to sacrifice all for the sake of heaven. Assist those who are following a call to priesthood and consecrated life to endure the hardships that their generous gift of self can bring upon them. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

3. The Crowning with Thorns - John 19:2-5

Lord God, your Word reaches to the ends of the earth. Send more ministers of that Word into the world to share the richness of your life with a world that so desperately needs it. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

4. The Carrying of the Cross - John 19:16-17

Lord, Jesus calls us to pick up our crosses and follow Him. May those who follow Him in lives dedicated to the Church find the strength to continue in their fidelity and joyfully bear their crosses for His sake. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

5. The Crucifixion - Mark 15:22-27

Lord, on the Cross Jesus offered you the perfect sacrifice: all that he had and all that he is. Inspire more young people to respond to your call to service in the Church with lives of total dedication to your People. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Glorious Mysteries - Wednesday & Sunday

1. The Resurrection of the Lord - Matthew 28:1-7

Heavenly Father, the resurrection of Jesus brought the hope of new life to the world. Help those who are called to make disciples of the nations to draw their strength and hope from the assurance that He lives and reigns forever. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

2. The Ascension of the Lord - Acts 1:6-12)

Heavenly Father, Jesus has promised to remain with His Church until the end of time. May those who are called to continue His work through the sacraments and holy witness be strengthened to carry out your will for the Church. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit - Acts 2:1-7,11

Heavenly Father, continue to send forth your Spirit to renew in your Church the call to serve you in the priesthood and consecrated life. May that Holy Spirit always be active in our lives. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

4. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - Revelation 12:1-6

Heavenly Father, Mary now enjoys the fullness of your life in heaven. Help us to realize that you have a plan for each of our lives and that our happiness lies in discovering and following that plan. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

5. The Coronation of Mary, Queen of Heaven and Earth - Luke 1:46-55

Heavenly Father, it is in humility that we discover how truly great our vocations are. Help us to serve you in humble ways so that others may see your light, rather than our own. We ask this, with Mary, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Litany for Vocations

Response (R): O Mary, intercede for us.

Mother of the Word Incarnate, help us to become more aware of the need for vocations to the priesthood and religious life... R

Mother of God, grant that others, like yourself, may say “yes” to your Son’s call to the religious life... R

Mother of the Church, may many workers be added to the service of your Son’s Church... R

Lady of Mercy, enlighten our minds that we may respond to our responsibility as parents to foster vocations in our homes... R

Queen of Heaven, help our young to follow your Son’s footsteps... R

Blessed Mother, open our hearts and minds to love our priests and religious, to recognize their humanness and their needs as we do our own... R

Queen of Angels, give our Church true disciples who will serve as priests, sisters and brothers... R

Dearest Mother, keep our young open to hear God’s call... R

Mother of Love, make us more open to the love our priests and religious have for us... R

Our Lady Queen of Heaven, help us to recognize that God alone does not call... R

Holy Family, help the families in this parish to discuss vocations to the religious life in a positive and encouraging manner... R

Queen of the Rosary, remind us to pray for our religious and those studying for the religious life, that they will remain zealous and dedicated to their call... R

Our Lady of Lourdes, we ask for happiness among priests, seminarians and all those engaged in a special Christian vocation to service... R

Silent Adoration

Approximately 20 minutes in duration

Invocation for Priests and the Religious Life

Leader: Lord Jesus, moved by Your great love for us, You remained with us under the appearance of the Eucharistic Bread. Prostrate in Your presence, we offer You our faith, love, gratitude and adoration, and place in Your hands all that we are and all that we have.

In union with Your most beloved Mother, we come here to accompany You and meet You as the Friend of our souls and the Light of our lives. In the wonderful works of creation, we discover the greatness of Your power and the glory of Your majesty, but in the Eucharist, we experience the joy of Your humble presence, hidden in the sacrament but revealed to every believing heart.

We come to offer You our heartfelt prayer for the world, for all people, for Your priests, and for men and women living the consecrated life. O Lord and Master of the harvest, we implore You particularly to send numerous and holy laborers to reap what You Yourself have sown in souls.

Response: We need You, Lord

Leader: We need men who will give You their mouths to speak to us of you, their feet to travel the world preaching your Gospel, their hands to bless us, their eyes so we can see how You look on us as a loving Father. We need You, Lord. The world and the Church need You. We ask You humbly and earnestly, to send us priests, vessels of Your saving power. Send us missionaries, consecrated men and women who will be light in the darkness of the world and salt to free us from the corruption of sin and evil.

Response: Lord, send laborers to Your harvest.

Leader: When You took pity on the crowd that followed You, and saw in it all the multitudes of people who throughout history would need shepherds on their journey toward You, You told us to pray. Hear now our humble prayer.

Response: Lord, send us the shepherds after Your own heart.

Leader: Lord, the fields are vast. Do not let the fruit that cost You the high price of Your passion and death remain unharvested for want of laborers to gather the harvest.

Response: Lord, send priests to Your Church.

Leader: The priest is another Christ. Through faith we see in him the Lord who walks with us in history. We honor him because in him we see Jesus Christ himself. A man among men, You have chosen him to celebrate the sublime mystery of the Eucharist, to perpetuate Your love through the ages, to forgive sins in Your name, to save in Your name, and to consecrate mankind and all creation in the name of the Blessed Trinity.

Response: Thank you, Lord, for the gift of the priesthood to Your Church.

Leader: Men and women who live the consecrated life leave everything in order to follow You alone, the Supreme Good, in perfect charity. They give their freedom out of love for You; they offer up the best of their affection and love to You; they follow You in poverty on the path of sacrifice. Great is their generosity and their consecrated life is a great gift to the Church.

Response: Lord, send Your Church vocations to consecrated life.

Leader: In the remotest places in the world, at times in the midst of persecution and at great risk, Your missionaries preach Your gospel to those who have not heard of You. They undergo loneliness, fatigue and misunderstanding, yet they bear it all with love so long as they can see Your love take root in the hearts of those people they reach out to.

Response: Lord, send missionaries to Your Church.

Leader: Lord, we are sure of Your promise, "I will be with you until the end of time." You are with us, and You never stop calling men and women to be at Your side in Your place as we journey toward You. You continue to pronounce the words that have changed the story of so many lives: "Follow me". Help those You call to be generous not to close their hearts to Your call, to answer it promptly, like the prophet Isaiah: "Here am I Lord, send me."

Response: Grant generosity, faith and courage to those You have called.

Leader: Renew all Your priests in their love for You and Your church: the fervent and the downcast, those who struggle, those who love You passionately, and those who have lost hope. May the virtues of purity, obedience, patience, charity, gentleness, understanding, a burning zeal for the salvation of souls, humility and simplicity, all shine forth in their lives.

Response: Grant us priests after Your own heart.

Leader: Lord, inspire and help those priests who work in seminaries and houses for formation. May they give Your Church saints, doctors, martyrs and apostles – a new host of witnesses on fire with zeal for the new evangelization.

Response: Lord, send us holy priests.

Leader: We pray to You, Lord, for all those who dedicate their lives to promote vocations. May they never cease to cast out their nets in Christ's name, to provide the Church with the vocations she needs to fulfill her mission.

Response: We need Your priests. Send them to us, Lord.

Leader: The enemy of our souls knows the good that a single priest does for the Church, and never ceases to lay traps for those Christ has called, tempting them to cowardice and to be more selfish and less sacrificial. Moreover, each one of those You have called has to overcome the atmosphere of the world, and his passions. We ask You to strengthen their souls and grant them the generosity and courage to reject firmly anything that could endanger their fidelity.

Response: Lord, help those You call to be generous.

Leader: Send us, Lord,

Response: Priests after Your own heart.

Leader: The harvest is great. The laborers are few.

Leader: You took pity on the crowds without a shepherd.

Response: Lord, send laborers to Your harvest.

Leader: For young people who feel Your call,

Leader: For zealous priests,

Response: Lord, inflame them even more with Your love.

Leader: For tepid priests,

Response: Lord, grant them Your holiness.

Leader: For priests who feel sadness,

Response: Lord, console them.

Leader: For priests who feel lonely,

Response: Lord, be their company.

Leader: For missionary priests

Response: Lord, fill them with Your zeal.

Leader: For young priests,

Response: Lord, move them strongly to seek Your glory.

Leader: For elderly priests,

Response: Lord, sustain them in Your service.

Leader: The harvest is great. The laborers are few.

Response: Lord, send laborers into Your harvest.

Leader: For our Holy Father, Pope N.____,

Leader: O Jesus, eternal priest, never cease to send to Your Church new priests and consecrated men and women, shepherds after Your own heart. We need Your ministers. We need Your envoys. They are the instruments of Your grace and love. They console us in Your name, they nourish our hope, strengthen our faith, and intensify our love. We need them, Lord, because we need You, we need Your love. Do not leave us on our own, Lord. Send laborers to the harvest of the world. Send fishers of men who will gather us up in the nets of Your mercy. With humility and trust we implore You to send us shepherds after Your own heart. The harvest is great. The laborers are few. Lord, send laborers to Your harvest. We ask this through Christ Our Lord.

Response: Amen.

Vocation Prayer

O dearest Jesus, Son of the eternal Father and Mary Immaculate, grant to our young men and women the generosity necessary to follow Your call, and the courage required to overcome all obstacles to their vocation. Give to parents that faith, love, and spirit of sacrifice which will inspire them to offer their children to God's service, and cause them to rejoice exceedingly whenever one of their children is called to the religious life. Let Your example, and that of Your Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph, encourage both children and parents, and let Your grace sustain them. Amen
